

# Cape Town & Peninsula



**Cape Town** is a remarkable and vibrant city with a rich heritage of African, Asian and European cultures influencing the rhythm at its' heart. Nestled in the shadow of **Table Mountain**, with views out to the **Atlantic Ocean**, it also enjoys one of the most breathtaking settings in the world.

## Activities and Attractions

A trip up to the top of Table Mountain in the aerial cableway or a helicopter ride will help you gain a geographical perspective of the Peninsula, although it is best to avoid a day when the 'Tablecloth' descends, covering the top of the mountain in white mist!

Cape Town itself is a fusion of old and new. The Victoria & Alfred Waterfront shopping and entertainment area, including the excellent Two Oceans Aquarium and the departure point for the the Robben Island Museum, is still a working port whilst the City Bowl incorporates both the business district alongside many historical buildings, museums and gardens.

The Cape Peninsula provides many opportunities for excellent days out, including the beaches of sophisticated Camps Bay or more informal Hout Bay, gateway to the stunning Chapman's Peak Drive. The road, carved in to the jagged rocks, winds its way towards Cape Point, the stunning tip of the Peninsula's mountain chain. Alternatively you can choose to share your beach with the African penguins at

## Boulders Bay near Simon's Town!

In-land you can explore the Constantia Winelands, home to historic vineyards with excellent restaurants. The world-renowned Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens has delightful trails through diverse fynbos flora and natural forest and is host to picnic concerts on certain evenings during the Summer months.

If you would like to incorporate a wilderness and San Rock Art experience to your visit, we recommend including an extension to Kamma Kamma or Bushmans Kloof in the Cedarberg Region to your itinerary, an enjoyable 3 hour drive away. Sanbona Wildlife Reserve near Montagu also offers Big Five game-viewing in spectacular yet tranquil surroundings.


In separate sections we provide information regarding the Stellenbosch Winelands as well as Hermanus, home to some of the best land-based whale watching in the world during the migration season. However, both regions can also be visited within a day from the Cape, making the City and excellent base for a longer stay.

## Accommodation


